### 19 1 Acid Base Theories

An acid-base reaction is a chemical reaction that occurs between an acid and a base, which can be used to determine pH. Several theoretical frameworks provide alternative conceptions of the reaction mechanisms and their application in solving related problems; these are called the acid-base theories, for example, Brønsted-Lowry acid-base theory.

An acid is a molecule or ion capable of donating a hydron (proton or hydrogen ion H<sup>+</sup>), or, alternatively, capable of forming a covalent bond with an electron pair (a Lewis acid). The first category of acids is the proton donors or Brønsted acids. In the special case of aqueous solutions, proton donors form the hydronium ion H<sub>3</sub>O<sup>+</sup> and are known as Arrhenius acids.
