Hormone - Hormones of the thyroid gland: The two thyroid hormones, thyroxine (3,5,3',5'-tetraiodothyronine) and 3,5,3'-triiodothyronine, are formed by the addition of iodine to an amino acid (tyrosine) component of a glycoprotein called thyroglobulin. Thyroglobulin is stored within the gland in follicles as the main component of a substance called the thyroid colloid.
